6 CHARTER RESOLUTION 18-CR-01

8 Charter Resolution of the Mayor and Common Council of University Park, pursuant to  
9 the authority of Article XI-E of the Constitution of Maryland and §4-301 *et seq.* of Local  
10 Government Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, as amended, to amend the Charter of the  
11 Town of University Park, to add Article I, "General Corporate Powers", Section 102,  
12 "Nondiscrimination".

13 Section 1: Be it resolved and ordained by the Mayor and Common Council of University  
14 Park that Article I, "General Corporate Powers", Section 102, "Nondiscrimination" of the  
15 Charter of the Town of University Park be enacted as follows:

16 SECTION 102. NONDISCRIMINATION

17 TOWN OFFICIALS, EMPLOYEES, AND AGENTS, IN CARRYING OUT THEIR OFFICIAL  
18 DUTIES, SHALL NOT UNLAWFULLY DISCRIMINATE AGAINST A PERSON BASED  
19 ON AGE, ANCESTRY, CITIZENSHIP, COLOR, CREED, DISABILITY, GENDER  
20 IDENTITY OR EXPRESSION, GENETIC INFORMATION, IMMIGRATION STATUS,  
21 MARITAL OR FAMILY STATUS, NATIONALITY, NATIONAL ORIGIN, PHYSICAL  
22 CHARACTERISTIC, POLITICAL AFFILIATION, PREGNANCY, RACE, RELIGION, SEX,  
23 SEXUAL ORIENTATION OR SOCIO-ECONOMIC STATUS.

24 Section 2: Be it further resolved that this resolution shall become effective fifty days after  
25 enactment by the Mayor and Common Council of University Park, Maryland, unless petitioned

2 Section 3: Be it further resolved that a complete and exact copy of this proposed Charter  
3 amendment shall be posted on the entrance door of the Town Hall of University Park, 6724  
4 Baltimore Avenue, University Park, Maryland, for a period of not less than forty (40) days, and a  
5 fair summary of this Charter amendment shall be published at least four times on four successive  
6 weeks within that forty day period in a newspaper having general circulation in the community.
