

Ordinance to Amend the Fiscal Year 2024 Budget

EMERGENCY LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION 23-O-08

Resolution and Ordinance of the Town of University Park, to amend the FY 2024 Budget Ordinance, Legislative Resolution 23-O-04, to transfer \$9,825 from line item A1, Salaries, in the Public Works budget to the A/C 7050-00 - Reserves - Bridges - Revenue line item, and to increase the A/C 7133-00 - Park Bridge Replace - Beechwood & Van Buren - Expenditure line item by \$9,825 in order to fully fund a change in the scope of work for installation of the Beechwood Road pedestrian bridge.

Section 1: Be it resolved and ordained by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of University Park that Legislative Resolution 23-O-04, Fiscal Year 2024 Budget Ordinance, be and is hereby amended to:

Transfer \$9,825 from line item A1, Salaries, in the Public Works budget to the A/C 7050-00 - Reserves - Bridges - Revenue line item and to increase the A/C 7133-00 - Park Bridge Replace - Beechwood & Van Buren - Expenditure line item by \$9,825.

Section 2. Be it further resolved that this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon enactment by the Mayor and Common Council of University Park, Maryland.

Section 3. If any section, subsection, provision, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be illegal or otherwise invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall be severable, and shall not affect or impair any remaining section, subsection, provision, sentence, clause, phrase or word included within this Ordinance, it being the intent of the Town that the remainder of the Ordinance shall be and shall remain in full force and effect, valid and enforceable.


