AMENDED EMERGENCY LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION 23-O-09

AMENDED EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AND ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF UNIVERSITY PARK, TO AMEND THE FY 2023 BUDGET ORDINANCE, LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION 22-O-04, TO ALLOCATE ~~[\$700,000]~~ \$512,240 TO REVENUE ACCOUNT 4170-00 RED LIGHT / SPEED CAMERA, TO ESTABLISH A NEW EXPENDITURE ACCOUNT, 5304-03 – “SPEED CAMERA FUNDS DUE TO THE STATE”, AND TO ALLOCATE THE ~~[\$700,000]~~ \$512,240 TO THAT EXPENDITURE ACCOUNT

Section 1: Be it resolved and ordained by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of University Park that Legislative Resolution 22-O-04, Fiscal Year 2023 Budget Ordinance, be and is hereby amended to:

Allocate ~~[\$700,000]~~ \$512,240 to revenue account 4170-00 Red Light / Speed Camera; Establish new expenditure account 5304-03 – Speed Camera Funds Due to the State; and Allocate the ~~[\$700,000]~~ \$512,240 to the new expenditure account.

Section 2. Be it further resolved that this Ordinance shall become effective immediately as emergency legislation upon enactment by four members of Common Council of University Park.

Section 3. If any section, subsection, provision, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be illegal or otherwise invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall be severable, and shall not affect or impair any remaining section, subsection, provision, sentence, clause, phrase or word included within this Ordinance, it being the intent of the Town that the remainder of the Ordinance shall be and shall remain in full force and effect, valid and enforceable.




