STATE GRANT STRENGTHENS POLICE

The Town of University Park has been awarded a \$65,588 State Aid for Police Protection (SAPP) grant for Fiscal Year 2026, thanks to support from the Maryland Governor's Office of Crime Prevention and Policy.

The SAPP program is a formula-driven fund that supplements local resources for police protection. Annual distributions are based on population, the number of officers in a department, and the community's taxable income, ensuring that towns like ours can sustain essential public safety services.

"We are incredibly grateful to the State of Maryland for this SAPP grant. This funding is a vital resource that supplements our operational costs, allowing us to enhance public safety and better serve University Park," says Chief David Coleman. "Our police department is deeply committed to both public safety and community well-being. This funding will help us maintain that commitment by making sure our officers have the tools and resources they need."

For University Park, this year's award will provide flexibility to strengthen operations and community engagement. Eligible uses include officer salaries, equipment and technology upgrades, investigative tools, training, vehicle operations, and outreach initiatives.

The grant ensures that UP continues to benefit from both professional service and strong neighborhood-police partnerships that make our town a safe and welcoming place.
